¹ The programme fee includes the examination fee.

² The programme fee of Postgraduate Certificate (PC) and Postgraduate Diploma (PGDip) will be determined based on the programme fee of the corresponding Masters Degree and requisite credit value quotient for the PC/PGDip programme (20/30 for PC and 25/30 for PGDip).

³ The programme fee includes a bench fee of Rs. 7500.00 per local candidate (Rs. 15000.00 per foreign candidate) and the examination fee. If the student is requested to resubmit the project report after major revisions, a repeat examination fee of Rs. 1500/- per local candidate (Rs. 3000.00 per foreign candidate) will be charged at the time of submission of the revised project report.

Students registered for the Postgraduate Certificate (SLQF 7), Postgraduate Diploma (SLQF 8) or Masters degree programme (SLQF 9) shall pay the Programme fee in full at registration or in two (*1/2 at the registration and the balance at the end of the first semester*) instalments. An additional payment should be made at the end of the first year to register for the relevant M.Sc. degree programme (SLQF 10).

The PGIS will retain 10% of the programme fee if the request for withdrawal is submitted **within three weeks** of the commencement of the programme. **No refund will be made after three weeks** from the commencement of the programme.

Other Fees

The other fees including registration fee, medical fee, library subscription, examination fee and deposits (science and library) should be paid according to the procedure stipulated by the PGIS.

M.Phil. [SLQF Level 11] and Ph.D. [SLQF Level 12] Degrees

Fees -

The fees may be revised as per recommendation of the Board of Management of the PGIS. All relevant fees should be paid at registration. Candidates are required to pay the relevant fees at first registration only for the remaining quarter(s) of the year (from the date of registration up to 31st December) on a quarterly basis. Subsequently, in order to renew the registration and maintain student status, the relevant fee/s should be paid on or before 1st January of each year. Candidates completing the programme during the course of the year are required to pay only for the relevant quarter(s) of that year on a quarterly basis.

² An additional late registration fee (10% per month) will be charged if registration for the due calendar year is not renewed before 31st January of that calendar year.

³ Tuition fee will cover the cost of (a) the 4- or 6-credit course requirement recommended by the relevant Board of Study and (b) the half-yearly progress review of the candidate.

⁴ Those who have completed the course work requirement and laboratory work (and have commenced writing up the thesis) are exempted from payment of Tuition and Bench fees. The exemption should be requested in writing from the Director of the PGIS by the candidate through his/her supervisor/s and the Chairman of the relevant Board of Study.

⁵ Supervision fee shall be paid for a period of 2 years for an M.Phil. degree and 3 years for a Ph.D. degree.

⁶ Examination fee may be paid at the time of submission of the thesis. If the student is requested to resubmit the thesis after major revisions, a repeat examination fee of Rs. 3000/- (M.Phil. degree) or Rs. 5000/- (Ph.D. degree) will be charged at the time of submission of the revised thesis.

OCCASIONAL STUDENTS OF THE PGIS

QUALIFICATIONS

On the recommendation of the relevant Board of Study the status of occasional student of the PGIS can be conferred on candidates with the following qualifications:

(a) Bachelor's Degree in Science or any other equivalent qualification from a recognized University

OR

(b) Any other qualification acceptable to the PGIS

Occasional students are those who are not registered for any of the postgraduate degree programmes of the PGIS. Two categories of such students are identified. They are those who:

- i. Would follow course unit/s from a currently running programme conducted by the PGIS and/or
- ii. Are attached to the research projects administered by the PGIS or by Teaching Panel Members of the PGIS

Local students with local grants, self – sponsored local students and Sri Lanka students registered in foreign universities but receive no foreign grants are eligible to pay at local rates. Local students sponsored by foreign grants will be charged foreign rates.

Occasional students should pay fees listed under (a) **AND** at least one from (b),(c),(d) and relevant fee from (e).

If any expensive equipment, chemicals are used, students will be required to make a payment to meet those expenses in addition to the above fee. The amounts are to be decided by the PGIS in consultation with the chairman of the Board, Supervisor of the student and the Head of the Department or Institution concerned.

Refundable laboratory deposit will be charged from those who will be engaged in laboratory work.
