## **ADVANCED COURSE IN ORGANIC CHEMISTRY**

#### Why do you need to follow this course?

The course will provide an opportunity to those who wish to acquire competence in Advanced Organic Chemistry. The course will be useful specially for General Degree or Applied Science students to pursue higher studies/research locally and abroad in disciplines such as agricultural chemistry, medicinal chemistry, pharmaceutical chemistry, natural products, pharmacognosy, biological chemistry, chemical ecology, identification of bioactive compounds and drug design, and other areas of studies that require a sound knowledge of organic chemistry. The course will cover important and key concepts upon which modern studies in organic chemistry are based.

- Advanced Spectroscopy and Separation (15 h) Techniques
- Biomolecules and Biosynthesis (15 h)
- Organic Synthesis and Drug Design (15 h)
- Structure, Reactivity and Stereochemistry (15 h)
- Tutorial Discussions
